| The Permit Holder shall be responsible for the fire(s) authorized by this permit and shall during light-up and for the duration of the fire, undertake the following: Provide one adult person equipped with a garden hose connected to a water source and shovel suitable to effectively safeguard the fire. Shall ensure the safeguarding forces to extinguish the fire(s) authorized by this permit until the fire(s) have been completely extinguished. Shall not start or rekindle fire(s) during windy weather and shall take such extra precautions as are necessary to prevent fire from escaping during windy periods. Shall totally extinguish all fires authorized by this permit on or prior to the expiry date of this permit: or shall extinguish them forthwith upon suspension or cancellation of the permit; or when instructed to do so by the <i>Fire Chief</i> or designate. Shall not allow burning to continue, where that burning, in the opinion of the <i>Fire Chief</i>, is a nuisance because of the emission of smoke and ash. Shall be responsible for all costs incurred to suppress any fire that escapes or threatens to escape from burning or that causes a nuisance because of smoke or ash. In the event of the Permit Holder failing to suppress any fire to the satisfaction of the <i>Fire Chief</i>, the <i>Fire Chief</i> may cause such fire(s) to be immediately suppressed. It is prohibited to burn rubber tires, tar, asphalt shingles, or any other like substances, which produce heavy black smoke on or in any fire authorized by this permit. This permit is subject to cancellation or suspension at any time at the discretion of the <i>Fire Chief</i> or an <i>Officer</i> of Nanaimo <i>Fire Rescue Department</i> where there is a violation of any condition under which the permit was issued. | | | | |

Special Event Burning Permit – Additional Conditions

Halloween Bonfire - Tuesday, October 31, 2018 only
Guy Fawkes Night Bonfire - Sunday, November 5, 2018 only

Under the "FIRE PROTECTION AND LIFE SAFETY REGULATION BYLAW 2011 NO. 7108" provisions have been made for these special events. There is a permit fee of \$50.00.

Burning Permits have to be obtained from Nanaimo Fire Rescue, Fire and Loss Prevention Division, 580 Fitzwilliam Street during business hours 08:30 to 16:30 Monday to Friday.

Burning Permits for Halloween Night must be obtained prior to 12 Noon on Wednesday October 31, 2018.

Burning Permits for Guy Fawkes Night must be obtained prior to 12 Noon on Monday November 05, 2018.

Permit Conditions

- Fires are only permitted from 6:00 PM to Midnight on the date permitted on the permit.
- All fires to be extinguished on or before midnight.
- All fires shall be on private property.
- Fires shall be a minimum of six (6) metres/twenty (20) feet from any building or combustibles.
- Fires shall be restricted in size to one and half (1.5) metres/five (5) feet across the base in size and may only be fuelled by hand feeding.
- The permit holder/property owner shall have a charged garden hose and shovel accessible at the location of the fire.
- The burning of household garbage is prohibited.

NOTE: No fires are permitted on City of Nanaimo property (i.e. parks, etc.) unless written permission from Nanaimo Parks, Recreation and Culture is obtained.

By submitting this form, the applicant agrees to all terms and conditions for a Special Event Bonfire. Should the applicant not comply with the terms and conditions as set out for the Special Event Burning Permit they acknowledge that they may be subject to a \$200 fine.
